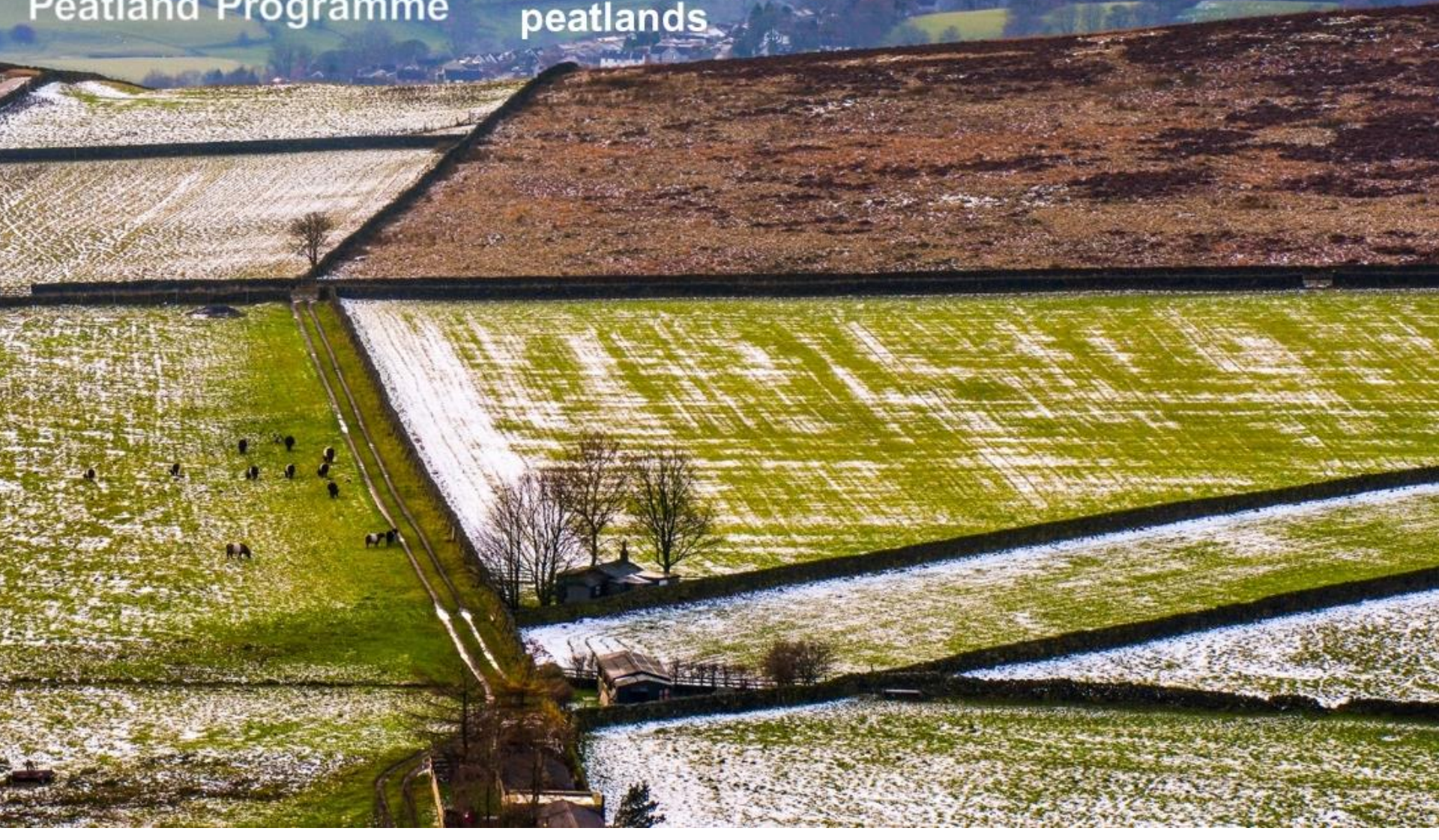

Peatland Programme

A UK Strategy aims to help to maintain dialogue across the 4 countries:

- Continued knowledge exchange and skill sharing between peatland partnerships, projects and practitioners.
- Being able to maintain national accounting mechanisms which are enshrined in UK law e.g. reporting on habitat conservation status or greenhouse gas inventories.
- Maximising efficiency through partnership working to develop shared funding schemes for UK peatlands.
- International collaboration to support action for global peatlands and climate.
