









Greenhouse gas fluxes

Degraded peatland
















What is the Peatland Code?

Only UK govt-backed, <u>domestic</u> voluntary carbon market standard for peatland restoration launched in 2015


- help companies to become carbon neutral/negative
- helps the UK to meet national GHG targets
- PC: restoration and/or rewetting

PC purpose is to underpin market trust and confidence

Eligible Peatland Types

Bog

Minimum peat depth of 30cm Duration between 30-100years

Fen

Minimum peat depth of 45cm
Duration between 30-100years
Water table measurements are required









Carbon unit types

PIU

Pending Issuance Unit: an expected emission reduction in the future

No offset claim can be made on this Legal contract between buyer and seller needed


PCU

Peatland Carbon Unit: a verified emission reduction that has taken place in the past Offset claim can be made on this No legal contract needed





Project timeline









Growth over time

- 301 Projects registered
- 91 validated
- 40,681 ha of peatland restoration
- 8.9 Million tCO₂e expected emission reductions over lifetime off all projects

Total expected tCO₂e emission reductions over all project lifetimes









Carbon finance examples

- "Restore your own" credits (~Insetting)
- Restore your land and sell PIUs upfront
- Restore your land and wait to sell
 - More and more landowners are waiting for a better price or in case needed against own emissions












Selling carbon units

- How much money can be made?
- Average price in 2022 was £24/PIU with a spread of £25 (UK carbon price index)
- What affects price?
- Location & access
- Type of project
- Vintage of units (& PIU vs PCU)
- Stage of project
- Benefits wider than carbon
- 'Security' of ownership/ delivery




